The purpose of the public hearing is to review community development and housing needs, inform citizens of the availability of funds and eligible uses of the state Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), and receive comments on proposed activities, particularly from lower income persons residing in the Town of Albion. The Town intends to apply for CDBG monies to construct water system improvements and/or update its water system planning documents.

Up to \$1,000,000 may be available to the Town of Albion on a statewide competitive basis to fund public facility, community

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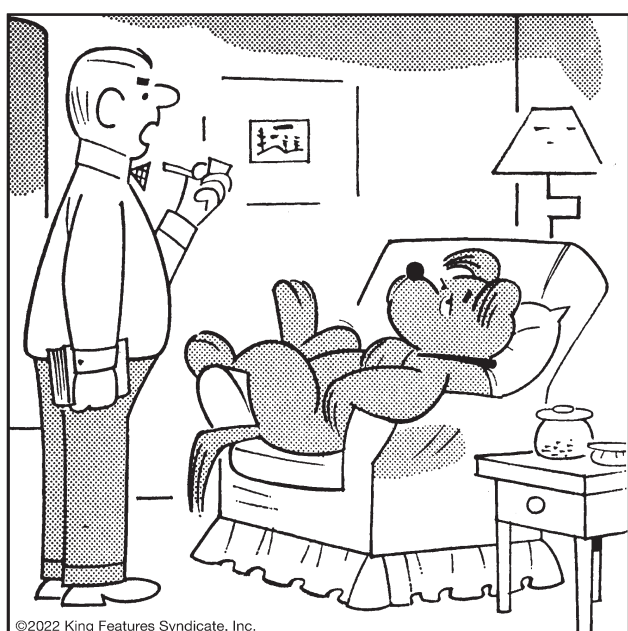
